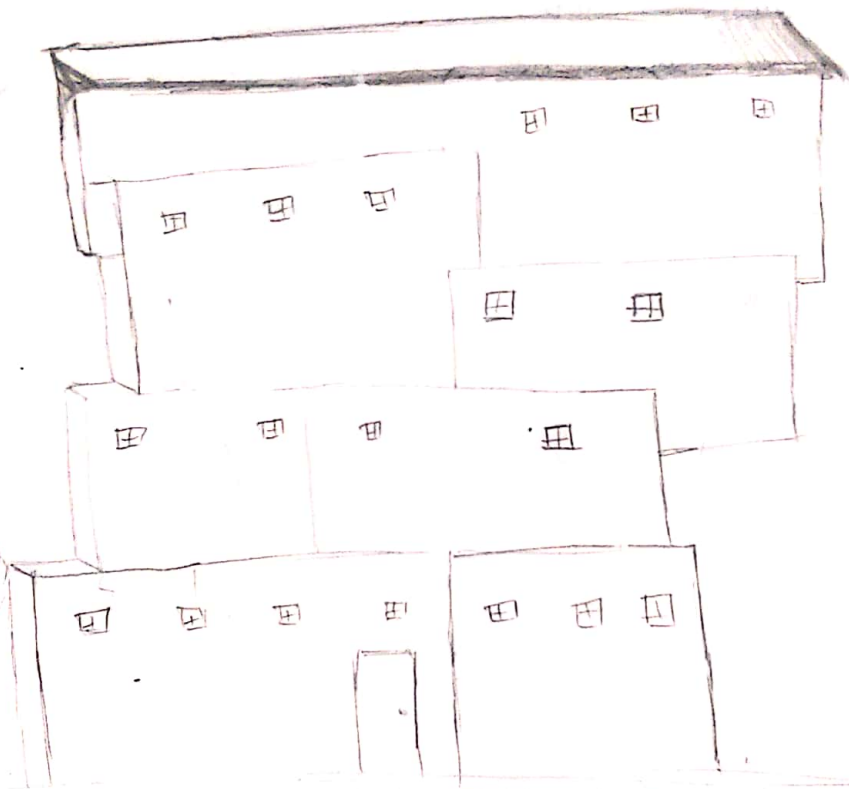

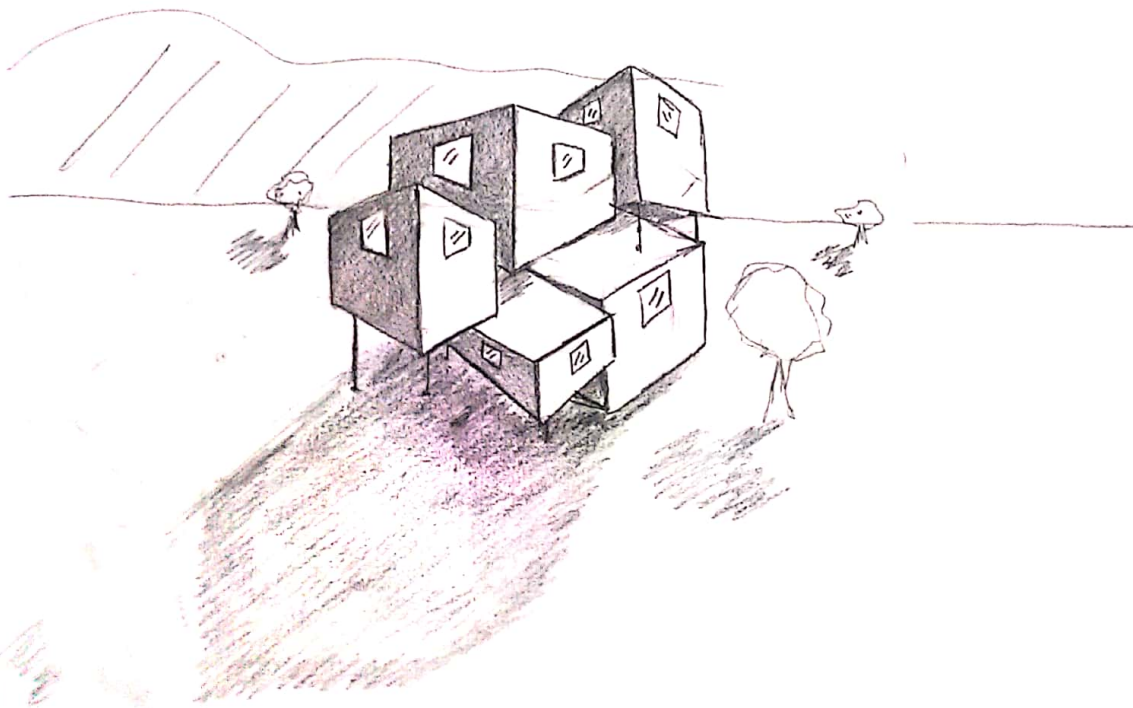

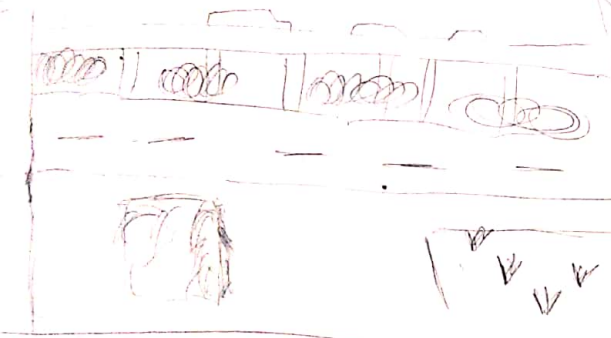

George St. wide area to accomide traffic & preserve heritage



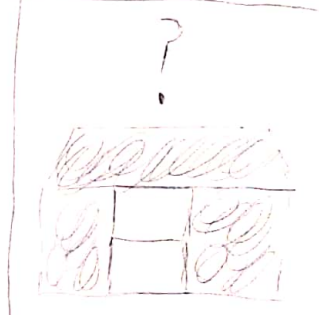
2. most Buildings are from the colonial style & are being preserved - its city's history

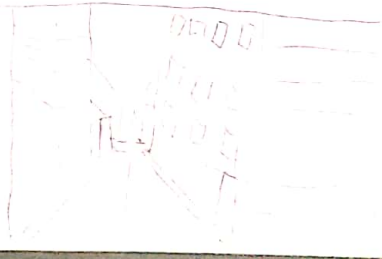

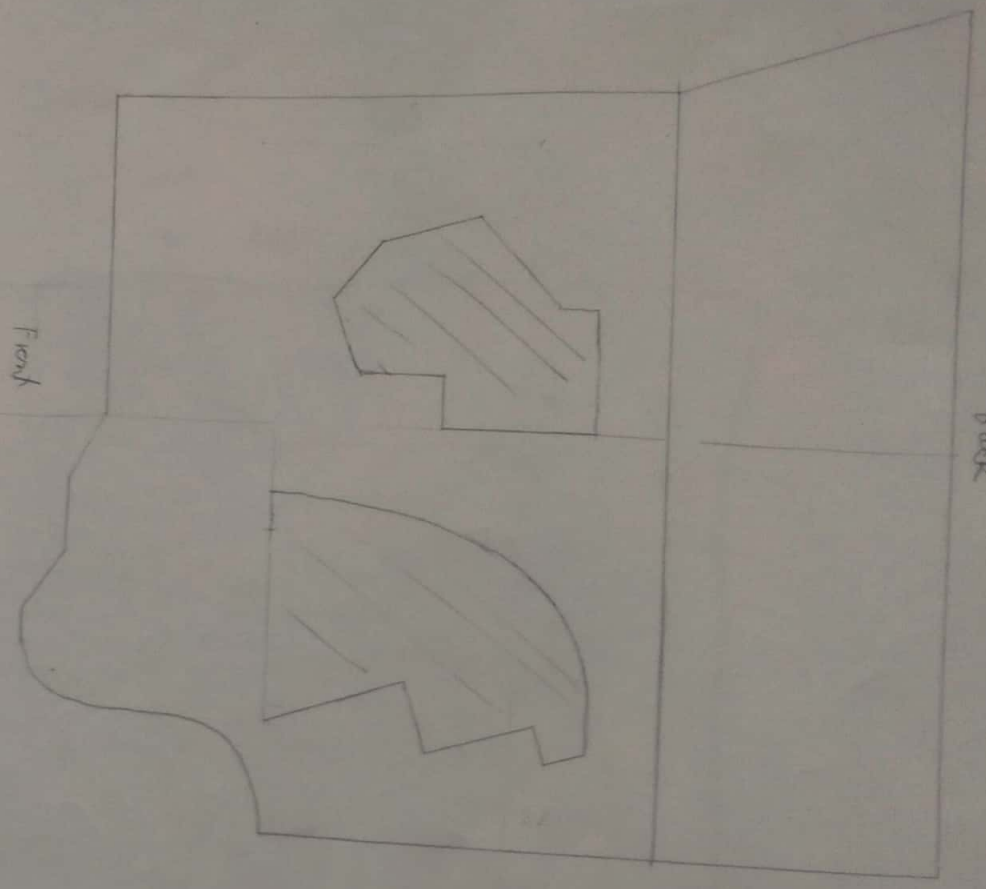
