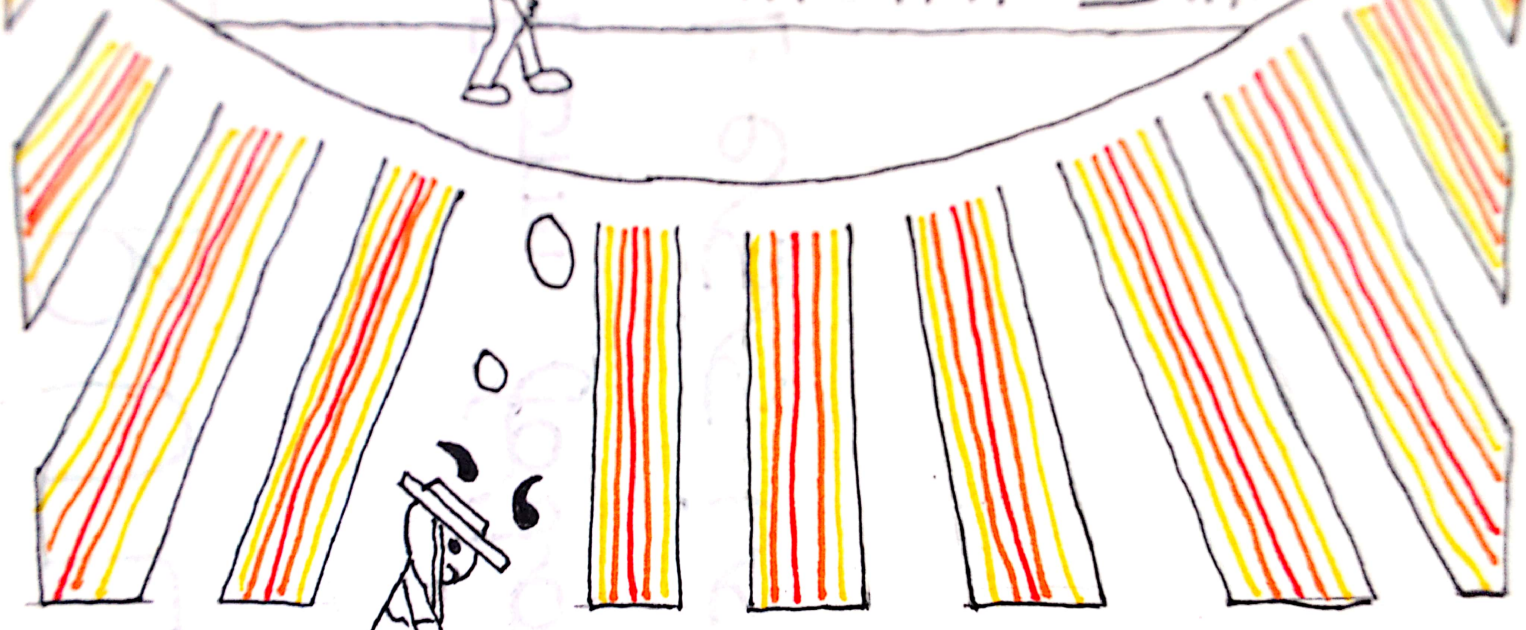


Atmospheric drawing of Brisbane at night, gives off cyber punk vibes.

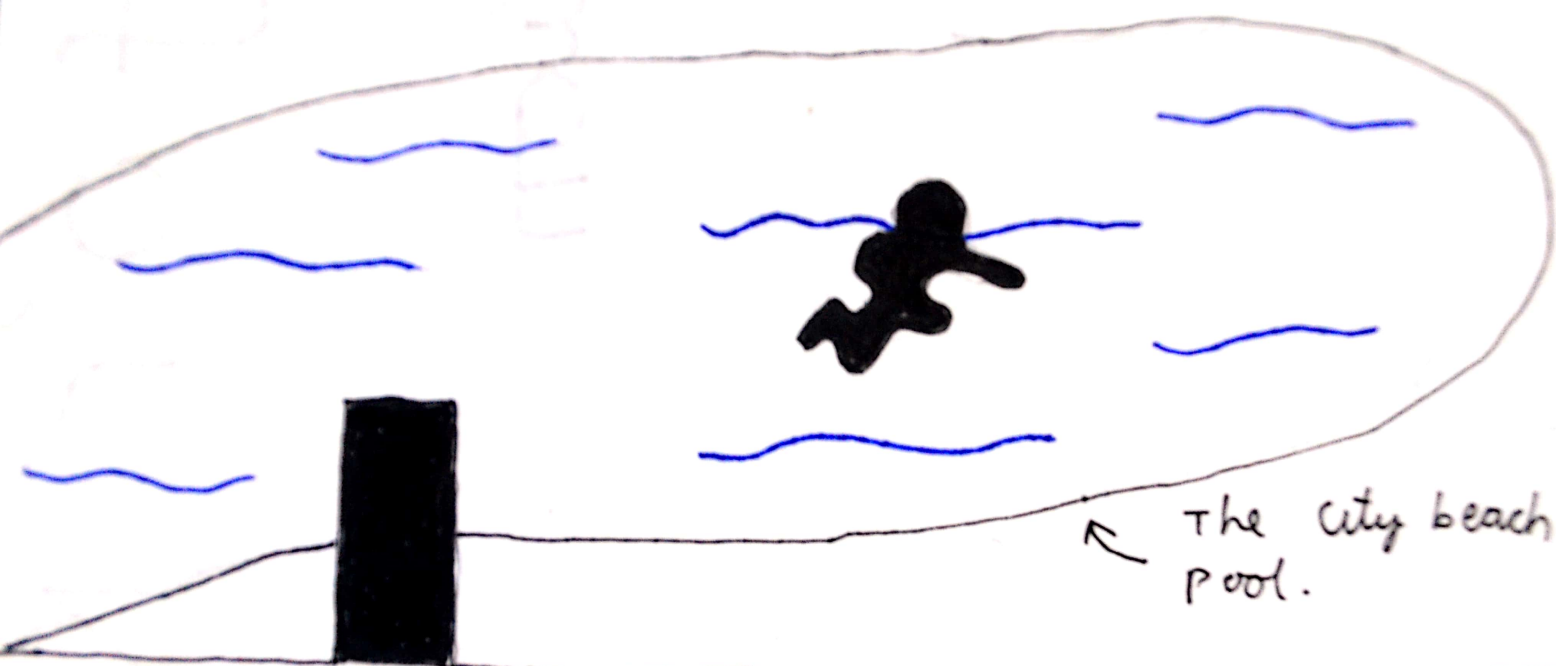

When I was doing the Architecture walk, it was very hot for me. But everyone else was ok. I feel that buildings that should suit the environment.

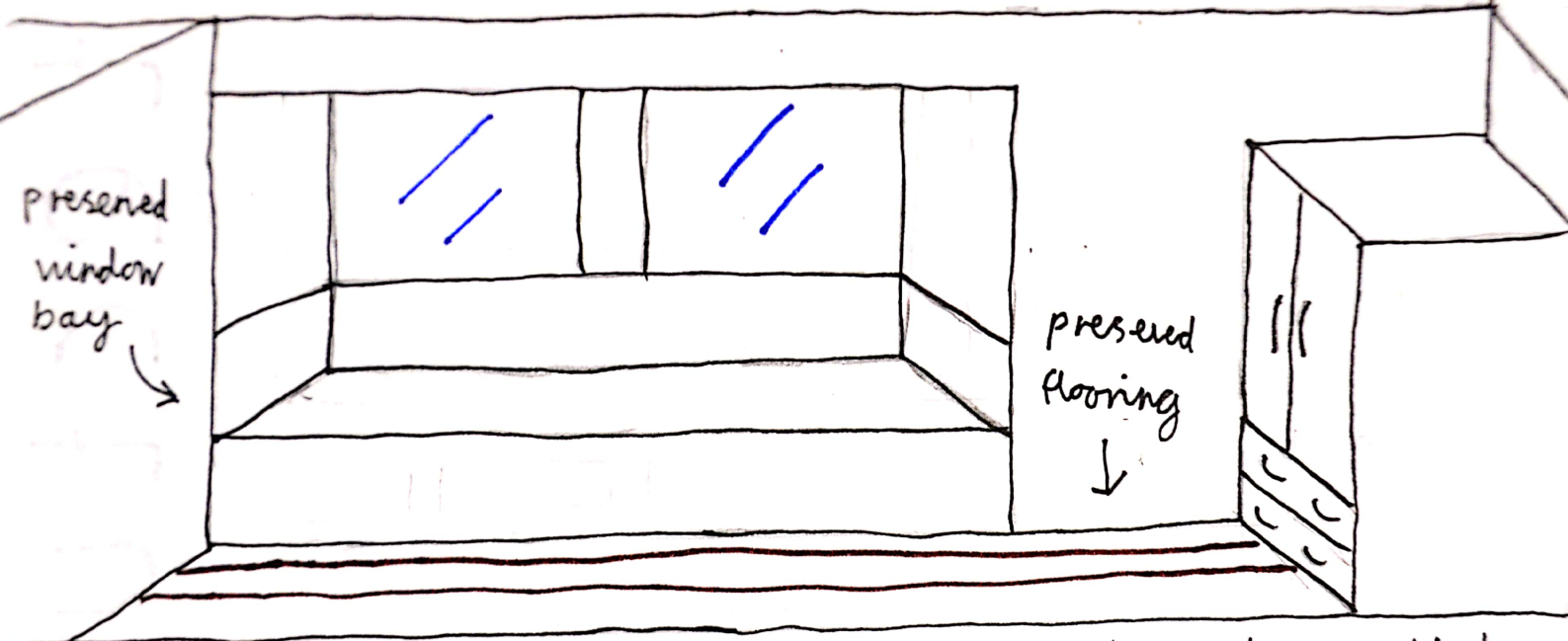

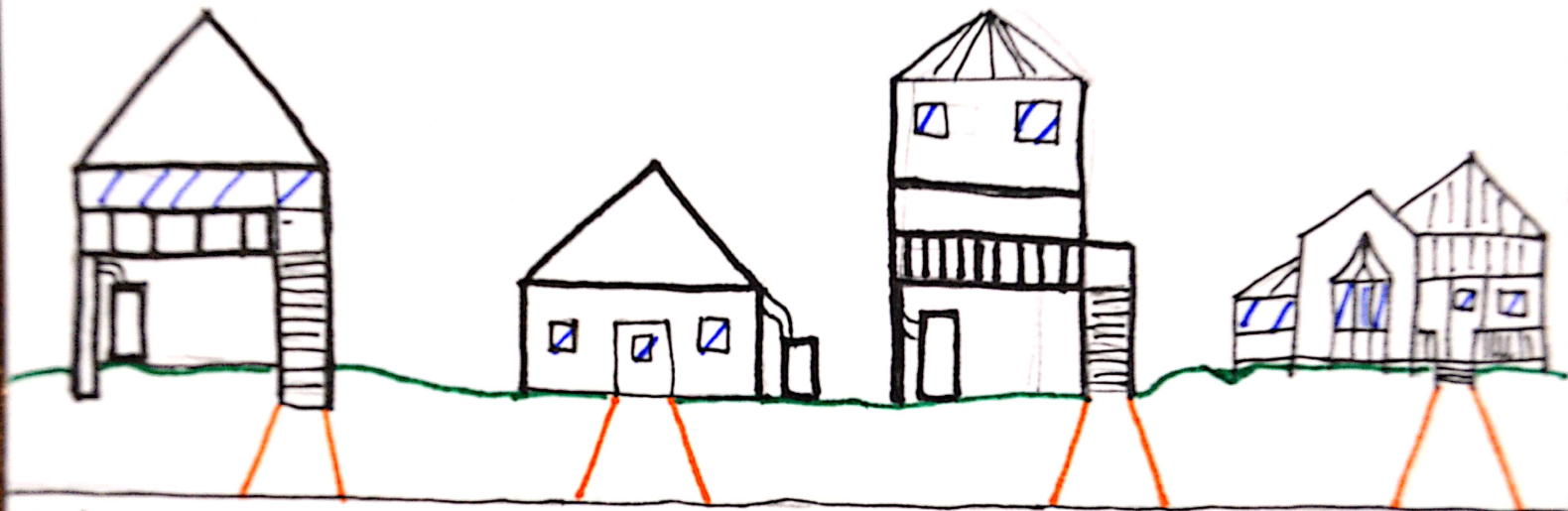

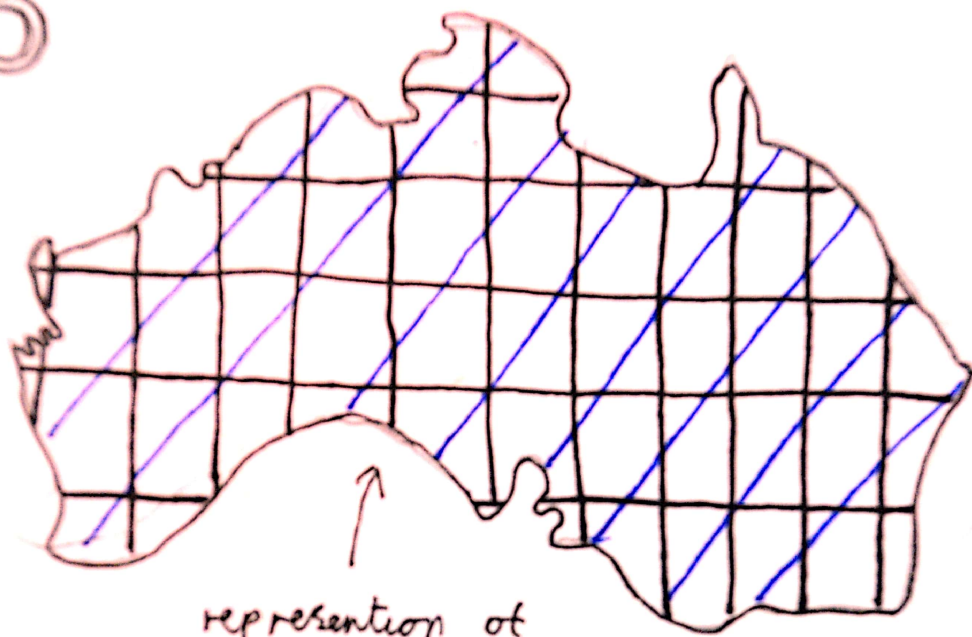


very often, there is this trend for minimal modern. which is nice, but lacks individuality. Rustic is nice because you can have old with modern.

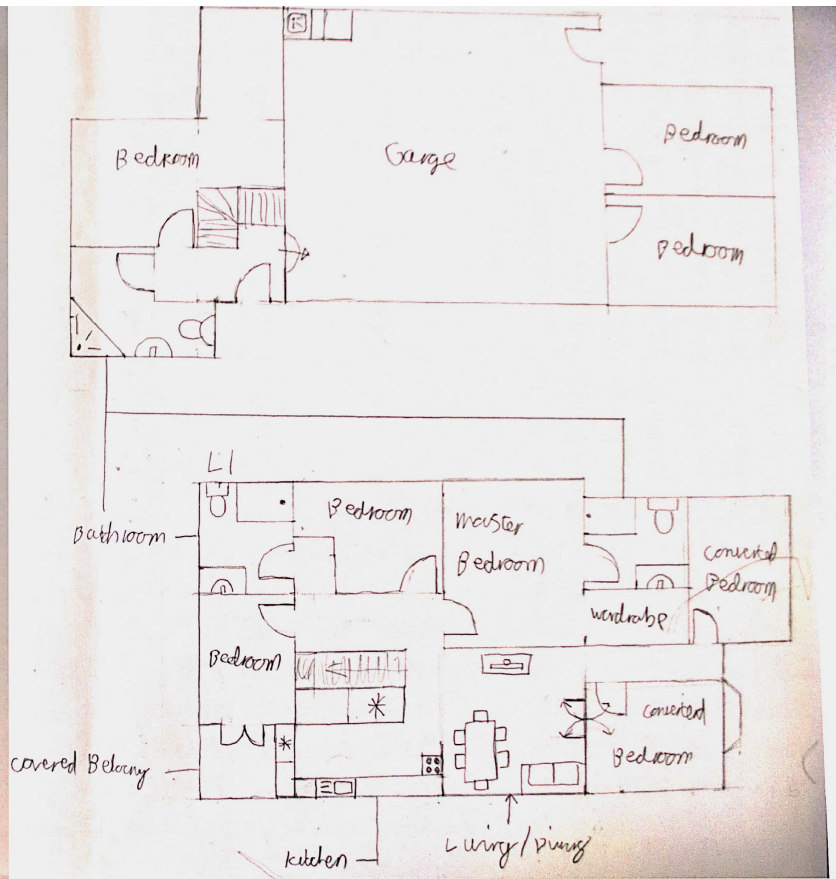
